

AUTHORITY OF BOARD MEMBER

Because all powers of the Board lie in its action as a group, individual directors exercise their authority over district affairs only as they vote to take action at a legal meeting of the Board.

In specific instances, a director, including the Chairman, may have power only when the Board, by majority vote, has delegated such specific authority to him or her. In all other instances, an individual director has no power.
