

COMMITTEE ON INSTRUCTION

The "Committee on Instruction," (COI) holding as its standards the School's Expectations for Student Learning and Mission Statement, is responsible for school-wide curricular issues that exceed the scope of individual departments.

The COI is an advisory body to the Principal. Its decisions are binding on the School subject only to the veto of the Principal, Superintendent of Schools, or School Board.

A veto by the Principal of a decision by the COI must be submitted to the COI within ten (10) school days of the passage of the decision and must be accompanied by an addendum outlining the reasons for the veto. By a 2/3 majority vote, the COI may present a dissenting opinion for a final determination to be made by the Superintendent of Schools.
