

FREE FOOD SERVICE

The Principal of each school, with the assistance of the school nurse or other appropriate personnel, shall determine whether there are children attending the school who need free meals.

In those schools operating food services, the Principal shall arrange to furnish each eligible child with cash on a daily basis to purchase a suitable meal. In those schools not operating food service, suitable arrangements shall be made by the Principal to furnish each eligible child with a "bag lunch" and milk each day that school is in session.

The Principal should report to the Superintendent of Schools cases of need for additional food assistance so that the Superintendent may confer with appropriate local and state welfare organizations.

All free meals shall be accounted for as may be directed by the Business Administrator. When in doubt, feed the student then seek permanent solutions!
