

STUDENT CONDUCT  
(Student Transportation Management)

1. Pupil are expected to be courteous at all times to the bus driver and all passengers. A few courtesies which should be observed are:
  - a) Select a vacant seat and remain in it until the bus reaches school or designated bus stop.
  - b) Conversation should be held in a normal voice level so the bus driver will not be distracted from driving.
  - c) Keep the aisles free of books, lunch boxes, and other objects for the safety of all concerned.
  - d) Keep your head, hands, and/or arms away from open bus windows to avoid accidents.
2. When crossing a road after leaving the bus, safety regulations stress:
  - a) Walk ten feet up the highway in front of the bus;
  - b) Look BOTH ways to be sure cars have stopped;
  - c) Cross in front of the bus.
3. Be ready to get on the bus when it arrives. A time schedule requires promptness.
4. Written permission from a parent must be given to the bus driver if a pupil wishes to be let off the bus other than at his/her regular stop.
5. No smoking is allowed on any school bus at any time.
6. The School Principal may suspend a pupil from riding the bus up to ten days for unsatisfactory conduct on the bus. A letter will be sent to the pupil's parents notifying them of any misbehavior which may require suspension of bus privileges.
