

**MINUTES OF THE
HANOVER SCHOOL DISTRICT SPECIAL MEETING
HANOVER HIGH SCHOOL GYMNASIUM
MAY 26 AND MAY 27, 2004**

Present were School District Moderator Tom Csatari; School Board members Kari Asmus, Nancy Carter, John Chamberlin, Dennis Goodman, Larry Pilchman, Anne Segal; Administrators Kenneth Greenbaum, John Aubin, Jane Weissmann; School District Attorney David Bradley, and approximately 150 members of the public.

Moderator Thomas Csatari called the meeting to order at 8:33 p.m. He read the Warning and noted that the Warrant was duly posted and that the returns of service were duly notarized.

Moderator Csatari then proceeded to the business of the meeting recognizing Board member Larry Pilchman for a motion:

Larry Pilchman moved and John Chamberlin seconded a motion that all voting on the main motion under Article 1 be by secret, written ballot in the form of the sample ballot posted at this meeting and that all such voting be at a recessed session of this meeting from 7 AM to 7 PM tomorrow, May 27, 2004 at the Richmond School Gymnasium in conjunction with the voting in the Dresden School District, and that after the meeting recesses tonight the only other business that will be conducted is voting on Article 1, the counting and announcement of the vote and adjournment of the meeting. After clarifying questions from a member of the public, the motion passed by hand vote.

Mr. Csatari then read the Article:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the District will vote to approve the cost items in the two year collective bargaining agreement reached between the Hanover School Board and the Hanover Education Association, NEA-NH, which calls for the following increases in teacher salaries and benefits:

Year	Estimated Increase
2004-2005	\$141,575
2005-2006	\$141,485

and further, to raise and appropriate the sum of One Hundred Forty One Thousand, Five Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$141,575), such sum representing the estimated increase in teacher salaries and benefits for the 2004-2005 fiscal year brought about by this collective bargaining agreement. (The School Board recommends this appropriation.)

NOTE 1. A favorable vote on this article shall be considered the approval of the cost items in both years of the proposed collective bargaining agreement.

NOTE 2. It is the School Board's intention to make a motion at the beginning of the meeting that all voting on Article 1 be by secret, written ballot at a recessed session of the meeting from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 27, 2004 at the Richmond School Gymnasium. If such motion passes, no voting on Article 1 will take place at the May 26, 2004 evening meeting and all voting on Article 1 will take place on May 27, 2004. If this motion is defeated, only those voters present at the May 26, 2004 evening meeting will
