

Questions for SAU Board

1. ***What is the survey format?***

ANSWER: The survey will have a series of “core” questions that will be asked of all teachers in the SAU and a “custom” set of questions that will reflect issues unique to a particular school or level of school

2. ***Will we have a series of faculty surveys or one “blanket” survey? (i.e. Will the survey Board effectiveness be separate from the information sought by the QEC sub-committees and/or separate from the information teachers want to share with the board)***

ANSWER: There will be one survey that will incorporate all of these areas

3. ***Who will receive results? (i.e. Will each school receive only it’s responses? Will the results be posted on our web site?)***

ANSWER: The consultant will prepare a report including the results and his/her analysis of the findings that will be widely disseminated.

4. ***Will the survey include open-ended responses, and, if so, how will those results be reported?***

ANSWER: To facilitate a timely response, the survey will not incorporate open-ended questions but will likely provide an opportunity for extended response questions. Extended responses will be reported in unedited form with ad hominem comments deleted.

5. ***How will the results be used?***

ANSWER: The SAU Boards will use the survey to devise strategies for improving employee relations at all levels of the organization and to identify organizational impediments to school improvement.

6. ***How often do we anticipate administering a faculty survey?***

ANSWER: The SAU Boards envision an annual survey with some modifications to questions likely.
