



Dresden School District proposes a \$1.14M or 4.04% growth in budget expenditures...



Net Assessment












Norwich Ed. Tax Rate Chg. Estimated Range (All Articles Included)



Hanover education tax rates have been falling in line with the FY19 and FY22 town-wide property revaluations








